
STATEMENT OF INTENTION

- Help manage the project team identification strategy, aligning with gaps to identify areas of need; and support the on-boarding and off-boarding of project teams.
- Work with the evaluation and learning team to coordinate the process around prototyping mindset, ideation and lifecycle.
- Collaborate with the communications and engagement team to prepare reports and updates on project team activity and support the ongoing development of public-facing language around activity.
